^{3/} The 20-cent per hundredweight processor assessment is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7CFR§1160.101 *et seq.*) imposed on any person who processes and markets commercially more than 3 million pounds of packaged fluid milk products on a monthly basis. Deliveries to consumer residences are excluded. Effective February 29, 2016, processors of certified "organic" and "100 percent organic" fluid milk products may apply for an organic assessment exemption for those products.

^{4/} The Class I skim price for the California Marketing Area is the higher of the advanced Class III or IV Skim Milk pricing factors plus \$2.80, subject to any adjustment for location.

^{5/} The Class I skim price does not account for the fortification cost associated with the California Minimum Solids Standards.

^{6/} The Class I butterfat price for the California Marketing Area is the advanced butterfat pricing factor plus \$0.0280 (\$2.80 divided by 100), subject to any adjustment for location.

^{7/} Class I Extended Shelf Life (ESL) Adjustment for All ESL products is equal to the average of the advanced Class III and IV skim pricing factors plus a 24-month rolling average adjustor less the higher of the advanced Class III and IV skim pricing factors. More information can be found in the §1000.50(r) section of the Federal Order language.

^{8/} The Class II skim price is the advanced Class IV skim milk pricing factor plus \$0.70.
